WHAT IS THE CLASS SCHEDULE?

HOW DOES MY TEEN GET A PERMIT?

Your teen must be at least 15 1/2 years old to apply for a permit. The first step is to enroll in our approved driver education Classroom course. Enroll in a Behind-The-Wheel course with the school of your choice. Take all of the required documents to a DMV Customer Service Center and pass the knowledge, road signs, and vision tests. Finally, your teen will have a picture taken and pay the permitting fee.

HOW DOES MY TEEN GET A LICENSE?

Your teen must be at least 16 years old, have passed the driver education classes, and have held a permit for at least 6 months before you may apply for a probationary license. You will also need to show proof that your teen has driven for at least 30 hours with at least 10 of those at night with a parent/sponsor. Your teen will take a driving skills test, and upon passing, will be issued a license.

DOES YOUR PROGRAM HAVE AN EXPIRATION DATE?

No. The program does not expire, but you should plan on completing it before you turn 18. Rules for obtaining a license are different for individuals age 18 and older and you may not qualify for an insurance discount if you delay past 18.

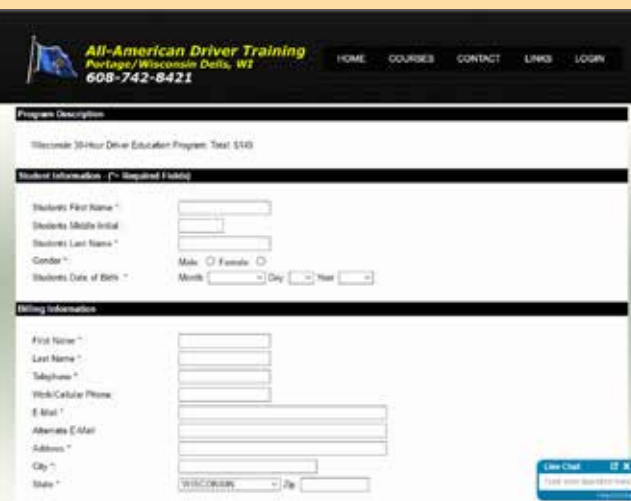
